- Automate vulnerability remediation with workflows that trigger patches and updates based on vulnerability scanning.
- Conduct regular penetration testing and/or purple teams to assess the effectiveness of current defenses and identify exploitable vulnerabilities.
- Create threat-based incident response playbooks.
